




ABOUT ALDEN






HOME SWEET HOME



We are both close to our families





Nafeesa's parents are from a conflict zone in the Himalayan mountains, in South Asia. She was raised with a strong racial consciousness, as her parents also came from a place where they faced oppression. Although they were immigrants, they emphasized reading books by Black authors, and they modeled solidarity by cultivating a multicultural environment both in community spaces and at home with Black folks whom she calls her aunties and uncles. Nafeesa grew up in a Black, Latino, Asian community within her schools, mosque, and close family friends. For high school, Nafeesa was sent to a white-majority school, where she faced rampant racism. As a woman of color, Nafeesa would not want to put a child through a similar experience.

CHILDCARE

BOTH OF US HAVE GENEROUS PARENTAL LEAVE FROM OUR JOBS.

Nafeesa plans to stay home for the first six to eight months, while Alden will also be able to take six months of paid leave from his work. After that period, Alden has access to the university childcare center and preschool, and a flexible schedule, as a professor, that will allow him to be home when needed. Nafeesa works remotely as an editor from home, and will also be able to help with child care needs. We live near Nafeesa's brother and sister, who would be able to help as needed, as well as many friends.




